The management of the North East Nursing College of Health Science (NENCHS) Lekhi is pleased to notify that admission for **B. Sc. (N) (4 Years) & Post Basic B.Sc. (N) (2 Years)** courses for the academic year 2023-24.

The North East Nursing College of Health Science Lekhi is located near Bage Tinali road District Papum Pare (A.P). NENCHS is dully recognized by the Indian Nursing Council (INC) vide No. 02/June/2014 Dated 14/06/2014 having institute code No. 031152 and affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University (RGU) vide No. AC-59/2008/Vol. II/1059 Dated 28/Nov./2014 the Arunachal Pradesh Nursing Council (APNC) vide No. Med/45/2014 Dated 21/July/2014.

The institute is also affiliated to the R.K. Mission Hospital, Itanagar for clinical training for the students. This institute is the first B. Sc. Nursing College in Arunachal Pradesh Estd. 2014 which offer B. Sc. (Nursing) course to eligible candidates in the state of Arunachal Pradesh. The 1st batch B. Sc. (N) students' were admitted in the establishment both in Government and private.

1. The Course Offer:-

Institute offer professional 4 years degree course in Bachelor of Science (Nursing) and 2 Years Post Basic B.Sc. (N) which is recognized by Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and Arunachal Pradesh Nursing Council (APNC), Naharlagun.

2. Duration of Course:-

- B. Sc. (N) – 4 years
- Post Basic B.Sc. (N) – 2 years

3. Admission:-

Interested candidate may contact institute office on all working days from **9:00 A.M to 3:45 P.M** for detail admission process. Candidate may also log on to website: <https://www.nenchs.com/> and register themselves for admission and upload the following documents:

- a. Pass Certificate and Mark sheet of qualifying examination (10+2)
- b. Pass Certificate of Class X along with Mark sheet for verification of Date of Birth

- c. Valid SC/ST/OBC Certificate issued by Competent Authority as per Government rule
- d. Six copies of pass port size recent photograph **(White Dress Only)**
- e. Registration payment receipt

4. Eligibility Criteria for B.Sc. (N):-

- a. Must be a citizen of India
- b. Candidate should be age between 17 – 35 years as on 31st December 2023
- c. Age relaxation of 5 years for ST/SC candidates & 3 years for O.B.C. Candidates
- d. Educational qualifications:
Must have passed 10+2/Intermediate/HS or equivalent Examination in Science with Biology, Chemistry and Physics subjects with minimum of 50% marks in aggregate (45% to 40% for ST/SC/O.B.C. candidates) from any recognized Board/Council/University.
- e. Candidate must have passed English subject with minimum of 40 marks in 10+2 examination.
- f. Candidate must be physically and mentally fit at the time of admission and during the duration of the whole course.
- g. Married candidates are also eligible for admission.

5. Eligibility Criteria for Post Basic B.Sc. (N):-

- a. Candidates should clear class 12th from recognized board preferably in the science stream
- b. Candidates should be registered as Registered Nurses and Registered Midwives (RNRM)
- c. Candidate should possess a three-year diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM)
- d. Candidates who have completed General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) can directly apply for Post Basic B.Sc. (N).
- e. Male candidates who have not done midwifery in GNM should possess a certificate in any of the nursing courses of 6-9 months duration prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council instead of Midwifery.

6. Criteria & process for selection:-

Interested candidate for the course may obtain prospectus and application form from the office by paying Rs.1000/- being cost of prospectus. Candidate may also logon to our website: <http://www.nenchs.com/> and get registered themselves by paying non-refundable registration fee of Rs.1000/-.

The selected candidates must produce the following documents in original at the time of admission:-

- g. Caste certificate ST/SC/OBC

- i. Admission Registration fee paid receipt
- j. Migration certificate (If candidate pass out from other State)

9. Payment schedule:-

Candidate may pay the institutional fee in two instalments and every month for hostel fee. Candidate selected for admission shall have to deposit a sum of amount equal to 50% of institutional fee being first instalment and a sum of amount for 1 month hostel fee in advance at the time of admission failing which the selection will automatically be cancelled. Second instalment of amount equal to 50% for institutional fee shall be paid on or before 31st January 2024.

10. Other Payments:-

- a. University registration fee/Examination fee and other clinical exposure tour expenses etc. shall be borne by the student separately from time to time as required by the regulating authority.
- b. Books & other stationary cost will be borne by the students.

11. NO REFUND: - Payment once paid shall not be refunded in any circumstances.

NOTE:-

- a. Beginning of academic classes will be communicated to the students in due course of time after consultation with Rajiv Gandhi University and APNC.
- b. Beginning of Clinical classes will be communicated to the students in due course of time after consultation with R.K. Mission Hospital, Itanagar (A.P)

12. Indemnity Bond With Surety:-

Indemnity bond with surety has to be signed by the legal guardian or parent for assuring payment to the institute for course fee which shall be liable to indemnify the institute all the fees/charges which the applicant/students could have paid to the institute had student/applicant completed her said course along with all allied loss and liabilities arising due to said vacancy created by leaving the course by the applicant/student.
