## ABOUT THE INSTITUTION

(N) & P.B.B.Sc. (N) programme established in 2014 & 2021 respectively, under the Abo-Tani Charitable society, approved by Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, Recognised by the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, Govt. of India and Arunachal Pradesh Nursing Council, Naharlagun, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh and affiliated to Rajiv Gandhi University, Rono Hills, Doimukh (A.P).

## VISION

atmosphere for learning and assimilation , Arunachal Pradesh is a land of rising sun , high green forests , deep river valley with all pleasant climate , friendly atmosphere , full of flora and fauna , religious monument etc. It is connected by rail, road, buses and Xylo/Innova daily services to Guwahati . The bus stand is just 1 km and railway station is about 10 kms away from the institute.

## **AIM**

Prepare graduate nurses who can make independent decisions in nursing care, protect the rights and facilitate individuals and groups in pursuit of health, function in the hospital, community nursing services, and conduct research studies in the areas of nursing practice. And also expected to take up the role of teacher, supervisor and manager in a clinical/public health setting.

## **OBJECTIVES**

On completion of the programme, the Graduate nurse will be :

1. Professionally competent to provide optimum health care services to all people irrespective of race, color, caste and creed regardless of socio-economic status.
2. Competent in the skills and techniques in nursing based on concepts and scientific principles.
3. Seeking opportunities for continuous growth for individual and for the benefit of family, community and whole nation.
4. Capable of leadership and supervisory roles in teaching and practices in health care settings as well as in the community.
5. Practicing moral and ethical values in personal and professional life.

## **IT'S URGENCY**

With the current issues and shortage in nurses in and around the world. The urgency to start the college of nursing in Arunachal Pradesh arises to bring forth competent nurses to meet the growing needs of the individual, community and hospital.

## ACADEMIC FOCUS

The programme is designed to develop an attitude in the students, provide necessary knowledge and skills to recognize and intelligently interpret the physical, mental and emotional manifestation of illness and prepare them to plan individual nursing care based on their unique needs.

The programme also helps develop abilities to work with other health care team viz. medical and paramedical personnel, devise disease prevention and health promotion programme, impart principles of hygiene to the public.

## CAREER SCOPE

Caring services including day care and residential care, Nursery, Primary Schools, family centres, hospitals, Voluntary sectors, cooperative houses, resorts the opportunities are limitless on a global scale. As India emerges as the healthcare tourism destination, employment opportunities to professional nurses only abound in future.

## COURSES OFFERED:

- B.Sc. (N) 4 Years
- Post Basic B.Sc. (N) 2 Years

## DURATION

- The programme shall extend over a period of four academic years for B.Sc. (N) and two years for Post Basic B.Sc. (N) including Integrated Nursing Training (Internship for 24 weeks). University examinations are conducted at the end of each academic year.
- The curriculum and the syllabus for the course shall be as prescribed by INC and is subject to modification from time to time.

## **INTERNSHIP**

- Internship means 8 hours of integrated clinical duties in which 2 weeks of evening and night shift duties are included in the final year.
- Internship should be carried out as 8 hours per day @ 48 hours per week.
- Students during internship will be supervised by nursing teachers.
- Fourth year final examination will be held only after completing internship.

## **MEDIUM OF INSTRUCTION**

English shall be the medium of instruction for all the subjects of study and for examinations of the Bachelor of Science Degree (N) Course and Post Basic B.Sc. (N) course.

## **ATTENDANCE**

- A candidate is required to put in a minimum of 80% of attendance in theory and 100% in practical/clinical separately in each subject every year before admission to the examinations.
- A candidate who lacks attendance of the clinical experience for reasons other than availing eligible sick leave (10 days) will be required to compensate during vacation.
- A candidate must have 100 % attendance in each of the practical areas before award of degree.

## **HOLIDAYS:**

- Four weeks of summer vacation and two weeks of winter vacation in an academic year as per notification of the Rajiv Gandhi University.
- All the gazetted holidays (3 weeks) notified by the Government of Arunachal Pradesh will be observed by the college in addition to 14th March, the Death Anniversary of Late T.C.Telli, founder of this Institution.

## ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION

### **B.Sc. Nursing:-**

- Candidates are also eligible from National Institute of Open School (NIOS) recognized by Central Government having Science subjects and English only (PCBE) .

- Must be a citizen of India

- Candidate should be age between 17 – 35 years as on 31st December 2022

- Age relaxation of 5 years for ST/SC candidates & 3 years for O.B.C. Candidates

- Educational qualifications:

Must have passed 10+2/Intermediate/HS or equivalent Examination in Science with Biology, Chemistry and Physics subjects with minimum of 50% marks in aggregate (45% to 40% for ST/SC/O.B.C. candidates) from any recognized Board/Council/University.

- Candidate must have passed English subject with minimum of 40 marks in 10+2 examination.

- Candidate must be physically and mentally fit at the time of admission and during the duration of the whole course.

- Married candidates are also eligible for admission.

- Gap certificate.

### **Post Basic B.Sc. Nursing:-**

a. Maximum age limit for Post Basic B.Sc. (N) is 35 years.

b. Candidates should clear class 12th from recognized board preferably in the science stream

c. Candidates should be registered as Registered Nurses and Registered Midwives (RNRM)

d. Candidate should possess a three-year diploma in General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM)

e. Candidates who have completed General Nursing and Midwifery (GNM) can directly apply for Post Basic B.Sc. (N).

f. Male candidates who have not done midwifery in GNM should possess a certificate in any of the nursing courses of 6-9 months duration prescribed by the Indian Nursing Council instead of Midwifery.

## **MODE OF SELECTION & ADMISSION**

Admission will be made on the basis of merit based on selection test .

## **ADMISSION RESERVATION**

Candidate of Arunachal Pradesh and its done by Government of Arunachal Pradesh on the merit basis.

- 50% seat for (APST)
- 25% seat for Foreign candidate
- 25% seat for management / others.

## **UNIFORM & BOOKS**

- The candidates are expected to have 5 sets of prescribed uniforms for the Entire course, i.e. 2 sets of classroom uniform, 2 sets of clinical uniform And 1 set of community health nursing uniform.

Students should buy the sports uniform suggested by the college if required.

- When in uniform, no form of jewellery is permitted to be worn except small stud earring and hair must be put-up with hair net.
- The uniform prescribed by the college will be made available to the Students on payment.
- The candidates are expected to purchase the text books, note books and Record books as per INC syllabus.

## **MODE OF PAYMENT OF FEE**

The fees should be paid in the form of crossed demand draft to be drawn in favor of the North East Nursing College of Health Science ,Itanagar .Fees, once remitted, will not be refunded. The fee structure is subject to revision from time to time .

Unsuccessful student intending to re-appear in the examination have to take re-admission in that particular class ..

- Prescribed fees of each academic year should be paid at the beginning of the session for each year. The exact fees to be paid by students of all categories will be made known at the time of selection / admission.
- No student will be allowed to attend classes unless she complies with all the admission requirements and pays all the fees for the year.

## GENERAL INFORMATION

- Students who voluntarily withdraw from the college shall be required to pay full fees for the entire course.
- The college does not take any responsibility for the loss of personal property. Students who keep any valuable goods such as jewellery do so at their own risk.
- Vacations are planned according to the programme. If a student is not able to return on time due to illness, the Principal should be intimated immediately, followed by a written explanation. On return she should submit a medical certificate issued by a registered medical practitioner stating the full details of her illness and treatment. Normally no other leave will be given.

3. Library : Sufficient number of books , nursing journals ,magazines are available in the library with latest editions .

## College Rules and Regulations

- Every student should obey the rules strictly, failing which his/her name is liable to be removed from the college.
- Any student found guilty of misbehaviour/misconduct/disobedience, persistent neglect of studies shall be liable to expelled from the college.
- All correspondence regarding college matters should be addresses to the Principal.
- Every student should obtain identity card from the college office on payment of prescribed fee.
- Original certificate will be retained in the college office and shall be returned to the students concerned after completion of this course.
- Students shall maintain decorum and cordial relation with each other; anyone found indulging in community discrimination shall be penalized by the college authority.
- The college authorities reserve the right to make necessary modification, alteration, addition or revision of the rules and regulations at any time and such changes should be duly complied by the students, institution and any one indulging in ragging is likely to be punished as per decision made by the anti-ragging committee.
- Order given by Hon'ble Supreme Court of India in the written petition (Civil) No. 656 of 1998, passed in 2001 directing all the educational institutions of the country would be followed in letter and spirit. Ragging is banned in the Institution and any one indulging in ragging is likely to be punished and the said punishment may include expulsion from the institution, suspension from the institution or classes or fine with public apology
- The punishment may also take the shape of:
  - i) Withholding scholarships or other benefits
  - ii) debarring from representation in events
  - iii) withhold result
  - IV) suspension or expulsion from hostel or mess and the like
  - v) any other legal step may be taken, if required.
- Fees to be clear before due date and if failed then late fine will be imposed a sum of Rs.100/- per day.

## HOSTEL FACILITIES

Hostel facility available for nursing students .

The furniture's viz. cot, table, chair, rack are provided for each student.

Hygienic kitchen and dining hall has been provided.





- No fees will be refunded if student drop out between academic sessions and also to clear all dues if not certificate will be withheld by the institution.
- Hostel fees will not be deducted/refunded unless college closed down/vacation for more than 20 days continuously.
- All students are to attain classes and clinical with full uniform.
- Students are to report to the concern Teacher for being absent or any issue arises.
- Students are compulsory to speak only in English during college hours.
- Students are not allowed to bring/eat any eatables inside the classroom.
- Students are not allowed to enter hostel during college hours without prior permission in case of urgency.
- Students are not allowed to put on heavy makeups and ornaments during college hours.
- No visitors are allowed during class hours unless emergency case arises, with prior permission from the Head of institution.
- No student is allowed to circulate any notice in Social Media that is circulated for the college purpose.
- No student is to circulate outside any information or event's that has arises within the college premises.
- No student is allowed to disclose any confidential matters related to the college/students/staff to any other third person.
- No student will be granted with any leave for family puja/party/programmes unless an intimate family passes away.
- Anyone found violating the above points will be given with warning and if found guilty again student will be directly rusticated from the college with penalty.

### **Unauthorized Meetings/Demonstration**

- Meetings, gatherings, demonstrations or strikes of any kind without the permission of the college authorities are declared illegal and will attract disciplinary action against the participating students.
- No malpractice during examination is allowed if found student will be ask to leave the exam hall and will be detain with penalty.

## **Use of Mobile Phones**

Usage of mobile phone is strictly prohibited in the college premises.

## **Attendance**

- A candidate must have 100 % attendance in each of the practical areas before award of degree.

## **Evaluation of Student**

Performance of the student is assessed by the system of:

- Regular periodic assessment shall be conducted throughout course. The average marks of the best two performances shall be taken into consideration for the award of internal assessment of marks both theory and practical.
- Percentage of attendance and submission of assignment on time is to be evaluated by the subject teachers.
- The student is expected to maintain high standard in academic and clinical performance throughout the programme. Note: Candidate shall submit a record of clinical work, assignment done during the academic year on or before 15 days prior to theory examination every year.



## ***Hostel Rules and Regulations***

1. No Student will be allowed to leave the hostel until they complete their four years course. (Hostel is mandatory for as per the INC rule, Ref. no- F.No-1-5/2014INC)
2. Hostel fees are not refundable in case the student leaves the college in the middle of the session and they have to pay the complete four year fees if they leave in the middle of session.
3. Every student should maintain proper conduct and discipline in the hostel.
4. The students are responsible to maintain the cleanliness of their rooms and bathrooms.
5. Monthly inspection of the rooms by the warden along with hostel committee will be conducted.
6. Playing loud music, talking loudly on the phone or any disturbing activity is strictly prohibited.
7. Any sick student should report to the warden immediately.
8. The students are responsible for their valuables and should be kept in their own personal belonging box properly locked. It is however advised that they do not keep cash and jewellery in the hostel to avoid any untoward happening.
9. Use of electronic gadgets except for mobile phones, laptops and iron box is strictly prohibited.
10. Meals will be served as per scheduled time and no food will be provided thereafter.
11. Visitors have to sign in the Visitor's register and meet the student in the Visitor's room only. No visitor is allowed in the hostel rooms.
12. Students can go on outing on Sundays only with prior permission of the hostel warden.
13. Hostel gates will be closed by 4 Pm and entry beyond 4 Pm is restricted.
14. Attendance will be taken at 7:00 Pm and all the students should be present for the attendance without fail.
15. The Students are not allowed to stay overnight at home except during Summer/Winter break.
16. Permission must be obtained from Principal/ in-charge in case Principal is on leave if any student needs to go outside the College Premises for Official/genuine reason.
17. Any candidate indulging in drug abuse, violence/misbehavior/ragging or not adhering to strict disciplinary rules and regulations will be liable for disciplinary action by the Hostel committee.
18. Any matter pertaining to the hostel should be first informed to the warden, who will take up the issue with concerned authorities.
